### **Ensino religioso e cidadania**

Num mundo que ergue fronteiras de arame farpado e em que o estigma do estrangeiro se inscreve a ferro e fogo no cotidiano, Políticas da Inimizade é um lúcido ensaio sobre a hostilidade e as formas que ela assume nas sociedades contemporâneas. Retrocedendo, na senda de Frantz Fanon, à tirania dos regimes coloniais e escravagistas como semente da inimizade global contemporânea, Achille Mbembe analisa os vectores desta violência planetária - que se manifesta na ressurgência de nacionalismos atávicos, na guerra contra o terrorismo, sacramento da nossa época, e num racismo de Estado que, a pretexto da defesa da civilização, varre réstias de democracia e suspende direitos dos cidadãos. Políticas da Inimizade relembra, em suma, que seremos sempre seres de fronteira e fragmentos de uma mesma humanidade.

### **O poder local em tempo de globalização: uma história e um futuro**

Com vasta e provocadora obra, Michel Foucault produziu diferentes maneiras de se

apreenderem os processos históricos, as racionalidades, as instituições, o presente, a ética, a vida e o próprio pensamento, problematizando o regime de verdade que tradicionalmente alicerçou as relações sociais. O pensador enveredou, na transversal entre a filosofia e a história, por várias temáticas, e suas ideias, hoje, inspiram estudiosos de diversas áreas e disciplinas. Conexões e interfaces entre diferentes campos de saber, utilizando-se de conceitos e noções do pensamento foucaultiano como ferramentas operativas, são as mais variadas e podem mostrar como a intensa produção intelectual do filósofo contribui para o questionamento de diversos campos do saber. Esta obra apresenta diferentes leituras de transversais entre a filosofia, a história e a educação, a partir de caminhos traçados por Foucault e que podem provocar deslocamentos de espaços disciplinares, rompimento de fronteiras e abertura de outras trilhas, indicando novas formas de problematização e de visibilidade do funcionamento da maquinaria social e, sobretudo, alimentar indagações e instigar o leitor a refletir sobre questões que entrecortam o tempo presente.

### **História da Cidadania**

Insurgent citizenships have arisen in cities around the world. This book examines the insurgence of democratic citizenship in the urban peripheries of São Paulo,

Brazil, its entanglement with entrenched systems of inequality, and its contradiction in violence. James Holston argues that for two centuries Brazilians have practiced a type of citizenship all too common among nation-states--one that is universally inclusive in national membership and massively inegalitarian in distributing rights and in its legalization of social differences. But since the 1970s, he shows, residents of Brazil's urban peripheries have formulated a new citizenship that is destabilizing the old. Their mobilizations have developed not primarily through struggles of labor but through those of the city--particularly illegal residence, house building, and land conflict. Yet precisely as Brazilians democratized urban space and achieved political democracy, violence, injustice, and impunity increased dramatically. Based on comparative, ethnographic, and historical research, *Insurgent Citizenship* reveals why the insurgent and the entrenched remain dangerously conjoined as new kinds of citizens expand democracy even as new forms of violence and exclusion erode it. Rather than view this paradox as evidence of democratic failure and urban chaos, *Insurgent Citizenship* argues that contradictory realizations of citizenship characterize all democracies--emerging and established. Focusing on processes of city- and citizen-making now prevalent globally, it develops new approaches for understanding the contemporary course of democratic citizenship in societies of vastly different cultures and histories.

History and Truth deals with the epistemological premises and the objectivity of historical truth as well as the social conditioning of historical cognition. Both the problem of the model of cognitive relationship and the problem of truth are discussed in the context of true cognition. Comprised of eight chapters, this book begins with an overview of historians' conflicting interpretations regarding the causes of the French Revolution to highlight the tendency of historians to differ in their visions of the historical process, resulting in different and sometimes even contradictory representations of one and the same fact. The discussion then turns to three models of the process of cognition (the cognitive subject, the object of cognition, and knowledge as the product of the process of cognition), as well as the concept of truth as a philosophical problem. Subsequent chapters focus on two concepts of history, namely, positivism and presentism; The class character of historical cognition; historicism and relativism; and the selection of historical facts. The book also considers why history is continuously written anew before concluding with an assessment of the objectivity of historical truth. This monograph will be of interest to students, practitioners, and researchers in the fields of history, philosophy, and the social sciences.

## **Universidade e sociedade**

Sérgio Buarque de Holanda's *Roots of Brazil* is one of the iconic books on Brazilian history, society, and culture. Originally published in 1936, it appears here for the first time in an English language translation with a foreword, "Why Read *Roots of Brazil Today?*" by Pedro Meira Monteiro, one of the world's leading experts on Buarque de Holanda. *Roots of Brazil* focuses on the multiple cultural influences that forged twentieth-century Brazil, especially those of the Portuguese, the Spanish, other European colonists, Native Americans, and Africans. Buarque de Holanda argues that all of these originary influences were transformed into a unique Brazilian culture and society—a "transition zone." The book presents an understanding of why and how European culture flourished in a large, tropical environment that was totally foreign to its traditions, and the manner and consequences of this development. Buarque de Holanda uses Max Weber's typological criteria to establish pairs of "ideal types" as a means of stressing particular characteristics of Brazilians, while also trying to understand and explain the local historical process. Along with other early twentieth-century works such as *The Masters and the Slaves* by Gilberto Freyre and *The Colonial Background of Modern Brazil* by Caio Prado Júnior, *Roots of Brazil* set the parameters of Brazilian historiography for a generation and continues to offer keys to understanding the complex history of Brazil. *Roots of Brazil* has been published in Italian, Spanish, Japanese, Chinese, German, and French. This long-awaited English translation will interest students and scholars of Portuguese, Brazilian, and Latin American history, culture, literature, and postcolonial studies.

In spite of a growing European commercial, religious, and political presence during the first three quarters of the century, outside influences were felt indirectly by most African societies, and they made a number of culturally distinctive attempts to modernize, expand, and develop. These are detailed in four thematic chapters, twenty-three chapters detailing developments in specific areas, and two concluding chapters tracing the African diaspora and assessing the state of the Continent's political, economic, and cultural development on the eve of the European conquest.

First published in 1943, *The Little Prince* by Antoine de Saint-Exupéry has been translated into more than 250 languages, becoming a global phenomenon. The Sahara desert is the scenery of Little Prince's story. The narrator's plane has crashed there and he has scarcely some food and water to survive. Trying to comprehend what caused the crash, the Little Prince appears. The serious blonde little boy asks to draw him a sheep. The narrator consents to the strange fellow's request. They soon become friends and the Little Prince informs the pilot that he is from a small planet, the asteroid 325, talks to him about the baobabs, his planet volcanoes and the mysterious rose that grew on his planet. He also talks to him about their friendship and the lie that evoked his journey to other planets. Often puzzled by the grown-ups' behavior, the little traveler becomes a total and eternal symbol of innocence and love, of responsibility and devotion. Through him we get to see how insightful children are and how grown-ups aren't. Children use their

heart to feel what's really important, not the eyes. Heart-breaking, funny and thought-provoking, it is an enchanting and endlessly wise fable about the human condition and the power of imagination. ## **Jardim de Histórias: discussões e experiências em aprendizagem histórica**

Since its original publication in Portuguese in 2008, this first English translation of Divining Slavery has been extensively revised and updated, complete with new

primary sources and a new bibliography. It tells the story of Domingos Sodré, an African-born priest who was enslaved in Bahia, Brazil in the nineteenth century. After obtaining his freedom, Sodré became a slave owner himself, and in 1862 was arrested on suspicion of receiving stolen goods from slaves in exchange for supposed 'witchcraft'. Using this incident as a catalyst, the book discusses African religion and its place in a slave society, analyzing its double role as a refuge for blacks as well as a bridge between classes and ethnic groups (such as whites who attended African rituals and sought help from African diviners and medicine men). Ultimately, *Divining Slavery* explores the fluidity and relativity of conditions such as slavery and freedom, African and local religions, personal and collective experience and identities in the lives of Africans in the Brazilian diaspora.

## **UNESCO General History of Africa, Vol. VI, Abridged Edition**

Este livro é fruto da pesquisa que teve como proposta analisar a coleção de livros didáticos "História - Sociedade & Cidadania", adotada por meio do Programa Nacional do Livro Didático (PNLD), utilizada pelos alunos dos anos finais do ensino fundamental em escolas estaduais do município de Bom Sucesso/MG. O principal objetivo deste estudo é perceber e debater como o discurso histórico que se refere à obrigatoriedade do ensino da cultura africana e afro-brasileira e indígena, se efetiva nas salas de aulas da escola pública a partir da Lei n. 10.639/03 e da Lei de n. 11.645/08.

## **The Politics of Education**

Brazil is a rapidly emerging country. Brazilian theology, namely the Theology of Liberation, has become well known in the 1970s and 1980s. The politically active Base Ecclesial Communities and the progressive posture of the Roman Catholic Church contrasted with a steadily growing number of evangelicals, mostly aligned with the military regime but attractive precisely to the poor. After democratic transition in the mid-1980s, the context changed considerably. Democracy, growing religious pluralism and mobility, a vibrant civil society, the political ascension of the Worker's Party and growing wealth, albeit within a continuously wide social gap, are some of the elements that show the need of a new approach to theology. It must be a theology that is both critical and constructive, resisting and cooperative, a theology that is able to give orientation to the churches, valuing and encouraging their contribution in society while avoiding attempts of imposition. The Churches and Democracy in Brazil, the fruit of years of interdisciplinary study of the Brazilian context and its main churches and theology, makes its case for an ecumenically articulated public theology. It seeks inspiration mainly in Luther and Lutheran theology, emphasizing human dignity, freedom, trust, the disposition to serve, and the ability to endure the ambiguities of reality, as well as a fresh interpretation of the doctrine of the two regiments. These are the fundamental elements of what makes human beings full members of the body politic: citizenship, their right to have rights and to be able to effectively live them,

together with their corresponding duties, in a move of growing political participation conscious of their religious motivation in view of the commonweal.
